

They began with a plan to place Bibles in hotel rooms where travelers might turn to the Word of God for encouragement and instruction. From those humble beginnings the organization now places Bibles around the world

in every imaginable venue. They have placed more than two billion scriptures in more than 200 languages in nearly 100 countries around the world. The organization supports its work through the gifts of Christians who share their goal to place Bibles in every conceivable venue.
